Poverty & The Church - We hear about rising grocery prices, housing crises, war, political turmoil, and people being forced into poverty around the world, but what is poverty and what are its implications on the mission of the Church around the world? We are going to delve into a theology of poverty, how we can be ambassadors of reconciliation, and how the global church is already acting as the catalyst for change in their communities.

This week we're welcoming Abby Bennett. Abby has been with Tearfund for 1.5 years. She previously ran a job training and mentorship program for people battling mental health, addictions, and homelessness and has a BA in International Development from Tyndale University (she wrote her Honours thesis on Reconciliation and Discipleship as an approach to International Development). Abby is passionate about how the church can be a leader in sustainable development and helping people lift themselves out of poverty. Abby lives in Barrie with her husband Josh, who she's been married to for 4 years, and they attend Barrie Free Methodist Church. She loves to travel, play volleyball, read, host themed parties, eat Greek food, and spend time with people.
