Let's Go Matthew 5:1-5 - This Sunday we will begin the Sermon on the Mount. This is arguably the single most influential sermon/talk/speech ever given in the history of the world. Ghandi read it every morning for years (though not a Christian) and he claimed that it influenced his pioneering non-violent revolution protest. Absolutely the Sermon on the Mount impacted Martin Luther King Jr's ministry, preaching, leadership and freedom movement. It is woven into the fabric of art, literature, law and values in Western culture, as you will regularly hear references to "turning the other cheek", "ask, seek, knock", "salt and light" and the Lord's prayer even. This week we will dive into the first three "beatitudes" Matthew 5:1-5.
